1. Date and Place

3. Rules

3.1 The regatta will be conducted in accordance with the 'Rules' as defined in the World Sailing Racing Rules 2025 - 2028, class rules.

4. Classes and schedule

4.1 The regatta is open to the following classes:

Topcat K1, K2, K3 Catamaran F18, Catamaran Open

Saturday - Sunday 7-8.06.2025

4.2 For the Catamaran Open class the TEXEL conversion system will be used.

5. Conditions of participation and registration

- 5.1 Registration at https://regattaiq.com by 05.06.2025.
- 5.2 Entry fee

Topcat K1, K2, F18, Open - 250 zł - crew of two

Topcat K3, Open - 150 PLN - single crew.

5.3 The regatta is open to competitors who possess the following

documents to be presented during the entry procedure

entry procedure:

- proof of entry fee payment,
- the helmsman should hold at least an amateur PZZ competitor's licence,
- yacht registration card or certificate.
- Third Party Liability Insurance: skippers of yachts entered in the regatta must have a third party liability insurance policy valid for the duration of the regatta, covering events occurring during the regatta for a minimum amount of 1.000.000 PLN.

Lack of a valid liability insurance policy will result in refusal of entry to the regatta.

6. Regatta programme

16:00 - Closing ceremony.

7. Amendments to regatta rules

- 7.1 The wording of rule 40.2 of the RRS is amended to read: Rule 40.1 shall apply, from the time a yacht goes down to the water, until it returns to shore.
- 7.2 For the classes: Catamaran Open, Topcat K1, Topcat K2, Topcat K3, the wording of rule 44.1 of the RRS is amended and the term 'may take a penalty of two turns' is changed to 'may take a penalty of one turn'.

8. Scoring

- 8.1 The Small Points System will be used, according to Appendix 'A' of the RGF.
- 8.2 8 races are scheduled to be sailed. If 1 race has already been sailed the regatta is considered valid.
- 8.3 In case of 4 races, 1 worst race result will be discarded, in case of 7 or more races the worst two race results will be discarded.
- 8.4 Classes will be classified if at least 3 boats participate throughout the regatta.
- 8.5 Competitors who have not completed any race or have been disqualified in any race shall not be classified.
- 8.5 Competitors who do not finish any race or are disqualified in any race shall not be classified.
- 8.6 On the last day of the regatta 08.06.2025 if the start procedure (WARNING signal) has not started by 13:00, the regatta will be completed with as many races as managed. 8.6 On the last day of the regatta 08.06.2025 if the start procedure (WARNING signal) has not started by 13:00, the regatta will be completed with as many races as managed.

9. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Regatta Office upon completion of the entry procedure.

10. Route

The regatta will be sailed on the course described in the Sailing Instructions.

11. Penalty system

Appendix 'P' of the RRS will not apply.

12. Reservation of liability

All participants take part in the regatta at their own risk. Nothing done or not done by the organisers shall release the regatta participants from liability for any damage caused by a competitor or his/her yacht resulting from participation in the regatta.

13. Prizes

Competitors placing 1st to 3rd will receive statuettes and diplomas.

14. Right of publicity

By entering the regatta, the competitor gives permission for his/her image to be used free of charge by the sponsors in photographs, films and other reproductions during the regatta and in all materials concerning the regatta.
